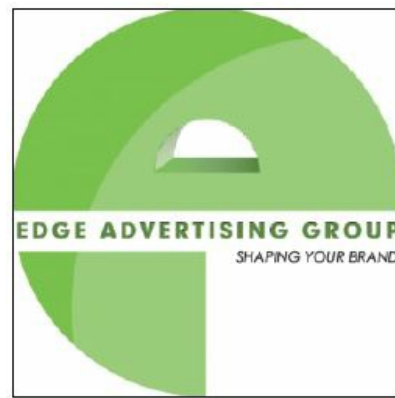
Advent House Annual Garage Sale

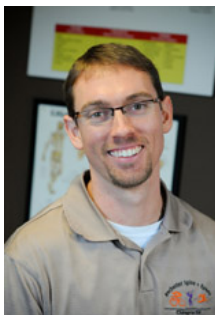
