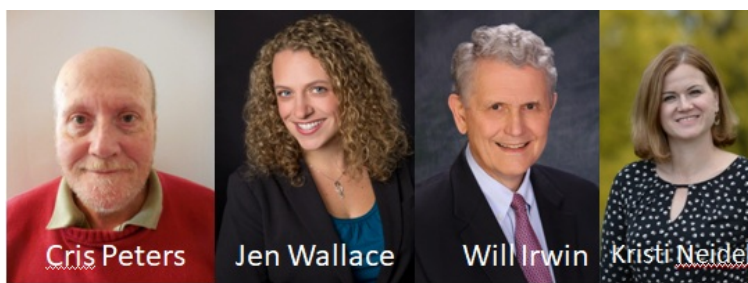

Music Project, "Music has always been a huge part of my life. I will enjoy being able to help students discover their passion for playing and challenge their abilities to make them the best musicians they can be."

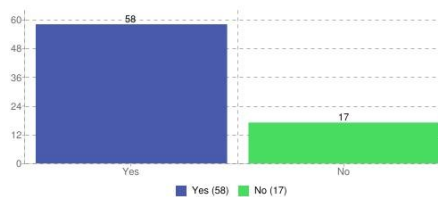
